CODE OF CONDUCT

It is vital that all involved in running or taking part in the Youth Academy (YA) behave in a way that brings credit to the YA's sponsors, the JCA, Cycling, and Jersey as a whole. The code set out below is designed to achieve this. The term 'riders' is used to describe both members of the Academy and adult coaches or helpers.

1. All riders when representing the YA at events and races whether on Jersey or off island must as a general rule wear the YA sponsored kit provided.
2. All riders must wear helmets when riding in the YA kit or taking part in any event or race.
3. All riders must refrain from using foul or abusive language whatever the provocation.
4. In the event of an incident the senior rider present should note details and notify the YA committee as soon as possible. In the case of emergency the senior member present should contact the appropriate authorities.
5. Safety is the first priority and YA riders must ride in a manner that does not place other riders or fellow road users in danger.
6. YA riders when taking part in events or races on Jersey or off island are expected to behave in a manner that reflects well on the YA.
7. YA riders taking part in races are expected to follow the directions given by the coach/team manager unless circumstances in the race justify deviating from these.
8. YA members when under the care of YA adult coaches/helpers are expected to behave well and follow instructions given by the adult.

Failure to follow the code may lead to the member being asked to leave the Youth Academy.
